There are plenty of reasons to lie awake at night: global crises, the rising cost of living, war, famine, dictators in power. But we'd argue there's another perfectly valid one: wondering whether Jack could've fit on the door in James Cameron's 1997 box office smash hit, *Titanic*.

For decades now, the great *Titanic* debate has raged on. In the film's final tragic moments, Rose floats safely atop a piece of wreckage while Jack freezes in the Atlantic beside her. But fans have long questioned the logistics: was there actually enough room for him up there too? Could they both have survived? Or would the added weight have tipped the makeshift raft, plunging them both into the freezing underbelly of the ocean—and erasing Rose's ability to tell the story at all?

We surveyed the VIFF headquarters for their thoughts.

Max, concession attendant, thinks both Jack and Rose could've definitely fit on that door. From there, the debate got icy.

"Yes, Jack could have fit on the door but they would have sunk!" cries Abbie, Ticketing and Customer Service Manager.

"I could write an essay about this! It's not about size it's about buoyancy," cries Marla, Government Relations Manager. Jeraldine, Program Administration Manager, backs Marla up on the buoyancy argument. Brittany, Social Media Producer, would never let a man risk her chance at survival. "They save women and children first for a REASON," she shouts.

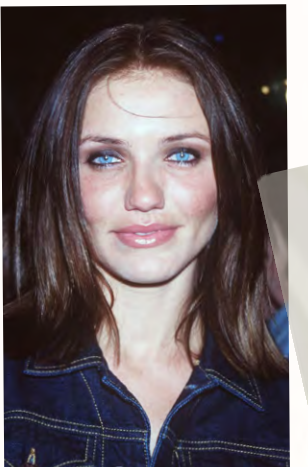
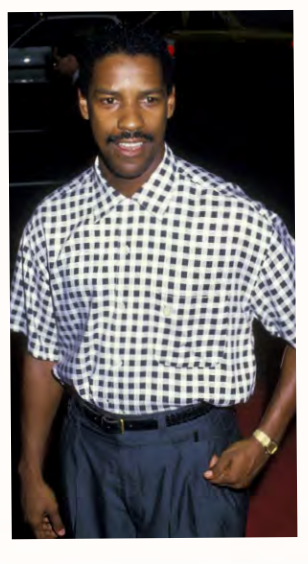
Elizabeth Hurley & Hugh Grant

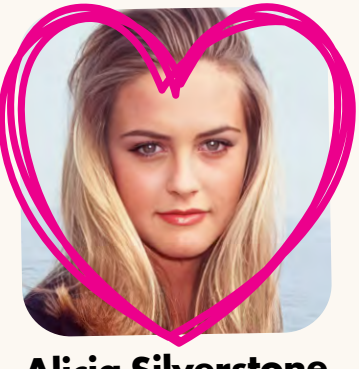

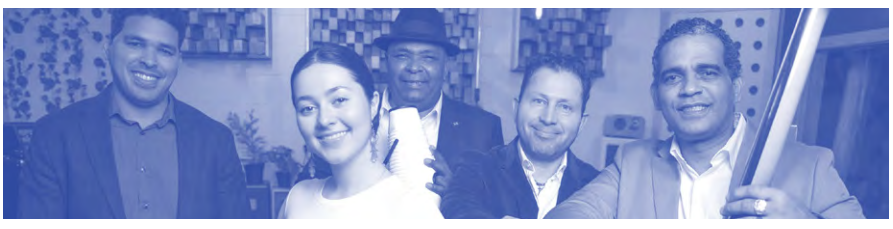
