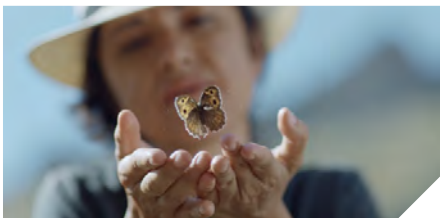


Cookie Queens
